- **Blacksmiths tools – especially anvils and leg vices**
- **Singer round-bobbin hand sewing machines**

This year we will NOT be wanting any gardening tools.
All tools will be serviced and checked before being sent, so please don't give items beyond economic repair.

Your gifts will make a life-changing difference to an individual or family. The income they could earn as a result will help them invest in better farming practices and provide school fees or school equipment for their children.

The tools and items we collect will be shared between people in our link communities in Kenya and the charity Tools for Self Reliance, who work in 6 African countries.
