I. Jesus, the Truth

Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me."

John 14:6

(stones and a pen)

This prayer activity is about praising Jesus for being true and trustworthy. Truth is solid, permanent, something we can rely on and hold on to, wherever we are in the world.

Pick up a stone and ask the Holy Spirit to remind you of something you know is true about Jesus, such as: Jesus loves me, or Jesus will never leave me.

Spend time praising and thanking Jesus as you write the truth down on the stone.

Use the stone as a visual reminder of Jesus' truth in your life.



2. Jesus, Prince of Peace

For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

Isaiah 9:6

This activity is an opportunity to thank Jesus that he is control, he has already won the eternal victory and to acknowledge him as Prince of Peace over all areas of our lives and over all the world.

Think of areas of conflict in: family, friends, work, neighbours, church, country and the world.

Pray for Jesus' peace in the different areas of your life and in the world.

Finish your prayers by saying, "In the name Jesus, Prince of Peace, Amen".

This amen is an act of giving everything to God, and thanking him that he is Prince of Peace in all circumstances in the whole world.
